RULES FOR TRANSPORTATION

1. Volunteer transport providers are expected to be prompt when meeting someone for a pickup or delivery. If any kind of a delay is experienced, the volunteer is expected to call the volunteer coordinator or other designated representative.
2. If the dog that is to be picked up appears to be vicious or overly aggressive, the volunteer is expected to decline DVPR service. We do not want to take in an aggressive or vicious dogs into our rescue.
3. Under no circumstances should a dog be left in a car unattended with or without open windows.
4. Volunteer transport providers should obtain a crate, lookout seat, or approved harness so as to safely transport dogs.
5. For long trips, food and water, as appropriate, should be provided to the dog. A leash should be used at all times, even when carrying the dog. Drivers are expected to obey all applicable traffic laws and speed limits.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND INITIAL WHERE INDICATED

The Delaware Valley Pug Rescue (DVPR) reserves the right to follow-up on any individual or family that fosters a pug. DVPR will provide the costs of veterinary care for the pug, provided that advanced notice is given and, unless it is an emergency, the pug is taken to one of our approved veterinary hospitals. Volunteers shall not transfer custody of the dog to any other person, business, or organization, unless authorized by DVPR to complete an adoption agreement with a specified person(s). Volunteers release and hold harmless the DVPR and its representatives from any and all costs, expenses, damages, or liabilities arising from the conduct of our rescue dogs. Volunteers hereby voluntarily and expressly release and waive any and all claims or causes of action which Volunteer(s) may have now or in the future regarding a rescue dog(s) against DVPR, its representatives, successors, assigns, agents, and attorneys.
