**RULES FOR FOSTERS**

- 1. Volunteer fosters are responsible for providing food and toys to a foster dog. Note that medical expenses, pending approval, are typically covered by DVPR, provided that foster provides a safe environment for the dog.
- 2. Volunteer fosters are requested to assist in transitioning a dog for adoption in a new home, which may include special diets, exercise, housebreaking, etc.
- 3. Volunteer fosters are expected to provide an honest evaluation of the temperament regarding a dog that DVPR will be placing. Frequently the complete history of a dog may not be known and behavioral or temperament problems may become evident, which may be serious enough to raise concerns regarding suitability of the dog for adoption.
- 4. Fosters work with a rescue coordinator or representative and the coordinator or representative has the ultimate responsibility for the dog and the right to place it as he or she feels appropriate. Foster is expected to introduce the dog to the prospective adopters. The adoption may or may not take place at the foster home.
- 5. Foster agrees to return dog to DVPR if, for any reason, the foster is unable to take care of the dog. Foster will report immediately any problematic or serious behavior or medical issue.
- 6. All DVPR dogs must be kept on a leash outside or must be within an approved fenced area.
- 7. In rare circumstances, due to severe behavioral or medical issues, DVPR may decide to euthanize a dog.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND INITIAL WHERE INDICATED**

The Delaware Valley Pug Rescue (DVPR) reserves the right to follow-up on any individual or family that fosters a pug. DVPR will provide the costs of veterinary care for the pug, provided that advanced notice is given and, unless it is an emergency, the pug is taken to one of our approved veterinary hospitals. Volunteers shall not transfer custody of the dog to any other person, business, or organization, unless authorized by DVPR to complete an adoption agreement with a specified person(s). Volunteers release and hold harmless the DVPR and its representatives from any and all costs, expenses, damages, or liabilities arising from the conduct of our rescue dogs. Volunteers hereby voluntarily and expressly release and waive any and all claims or causes of action which Volunteer(s) may have now or in the future regarding a rescue dog(s) against DVPR, its representatives, successors, assigns, agents, and attorneys.
